The Cambridge Center for Behavioral Studies (Center) policy for granting permission to reproduce its copyrighted material is similar to that of the American Psychological Association:

Publishers, authors, or editors must secure from the Center written permission to reproduce a journal article in full or journal text of more than 500 words, or any video or audio reproduction.

The Center grants permission contingent upon reasonable attempts to secure like permission of the author or producer, inclusion of the Center copyright notice on the first page of the reproduced material, links to the Cambridge Center' website www.behavior.org for any Internet publication or advertising, and payment of a fee of \$30 per page.

Requesting permission for use of a single table or figure will be assessed a \$30 service fee.

Permission and fees are waived for authors or producers who wish to reproduce their own material for personal use, provided that full credit is given to the Center as copyright holder.

Fees are also waived for library reserve use by instructors and educational institutions provided that full credit is given to the Center as copyright holder and to the author or producer through a complete citation. A separate agreement for permission is given on request.
